Registration Fee, Monthly Tuition, and all Practice Wear & Performance Costuming costs are non-refundable. 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Braves' Rhythm Nation Junior High Dance Team Code of Conduct Contract

Purpose: As a member of this Dance Team, you represent Three Way ISD and Happy Toes Dance. Your conduct and actions in the classroom, on the court/field, and in the community should not deviate from the regulations and code of conduct set by the school and the athletic department. Team members must show determination, dedication, and desire to be a productive member of this team.

Dedication: There is a level of commitment required to be a part of this Dance Team. You must have a desired level of commitment not just for yourself, but for your ENTIRE team. Being on this team we depend on all of our other dance mates to be at practice consistently and do their part in having the knowledge of their routine.

Be Appropriate: We expect our dancers to uphold appropriate behavior at all times. If your actions are not deemed appropriate and do not coincide with the Three Way ISD student code of conduct, you may be unable to perform during TWISD events.

Closed Door Policy: We will have a closed-door policy at all practices. Dancers are better focused without the distraction of parents, siblings, and friends.

Cell Phone Policy: Dancers will not be allowed to be on their cell phones once practice begins. If there is an emergency, parents may contact Ms. Tiffany or Ms. Michelle.

Attendance: If you know in advance that you will be late or will be missing a practice/performance, you are to advise Ms. Tiffany or Ms. Michelle immediately. If you are going to miss practice, you must call/text ahead of time. Dancers must be present at every practice, for the entire practice time, in order to be eligible to participate in upcoming TWISD event performances. If you miss a practice, you must make up the material you missed before the next practice. It is your responsibility to catch up. Unfortunately, when you miss a practice, it affects the whole dance team.

Practice Etiquette and Behavior: Attitude is very important. Dancers are expected to come to practice with a ready to dance attitude. Unruly behavior, excessive talking, non-participation, or any disruptive behavior will result in parent communication.

Uniforms/Practice Attire: Proper dancewear and jazz shoes are required at all practices. Uniforms/Practice attire must be kept clean and in good repair. Dancers may not wear jewelry outside of stud earrings and may not have long/pointy nails due to safety concerns.

Performances: Performances include, but are not limited to, a Christmas Program at TWISD, halftime performance during home games for the Junior High Basketball Team, and our annual Spring Recital held in Glen Rose. All performances will be mandatory and a schedule will be released once dates are confirmed with TWISD.
